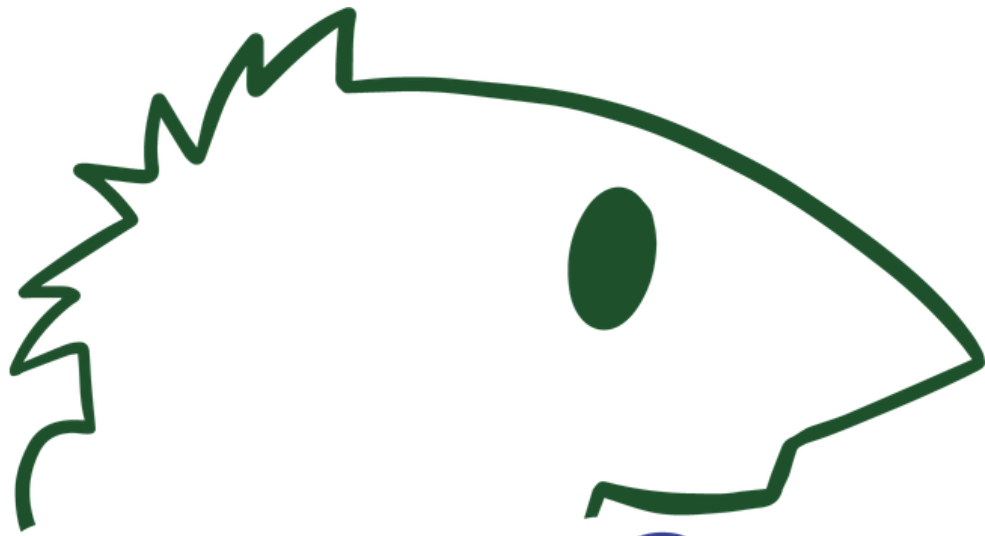




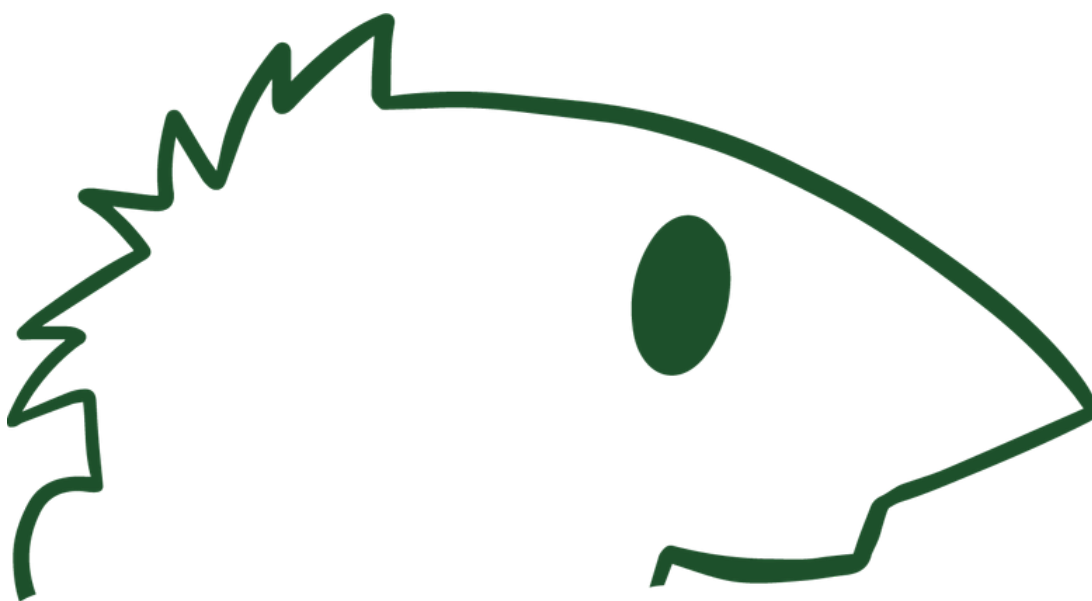
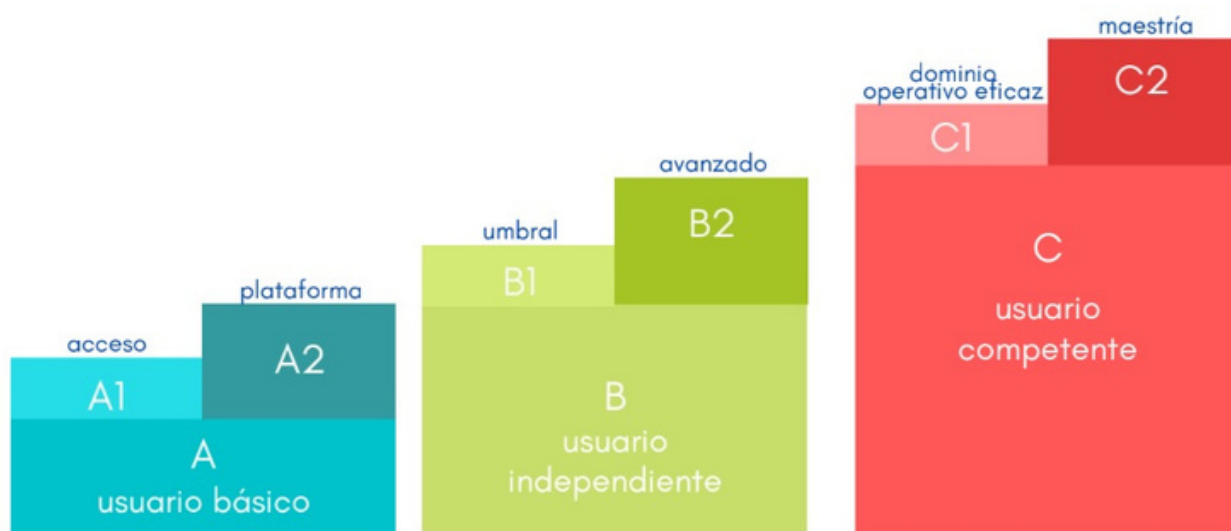

- Handle most situations you may encounter while travelling in a Spanish-speaking country.
- Produce simple, coherent texts on topics that are familiar to you or of personal interest.
- Describe experiences, events, wishes, and aspirations, and give brief reasons and explanations for your opinions and future plans.

WRITINGS

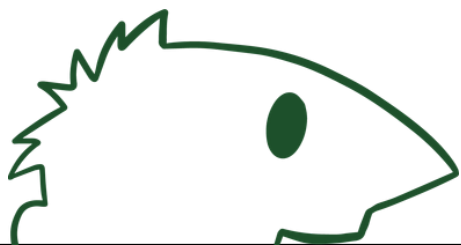


You will learn to write using the main verb tenses: past, present and future. You will be able to write a short story.
