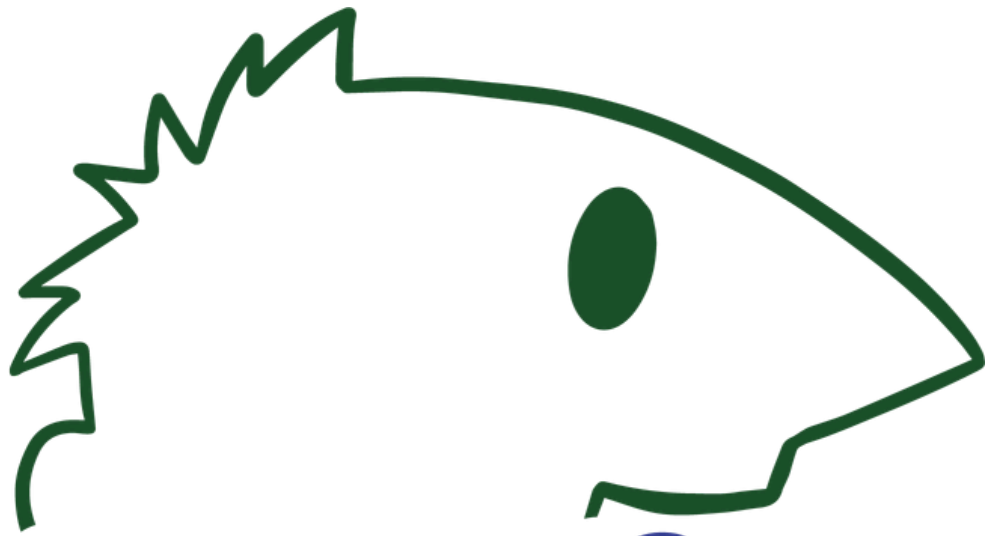


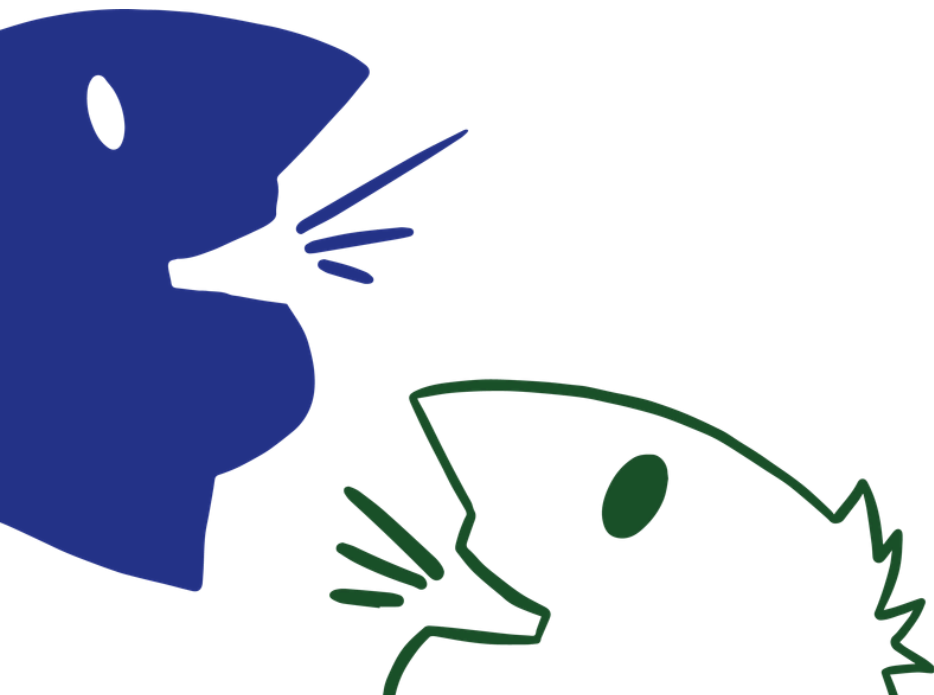
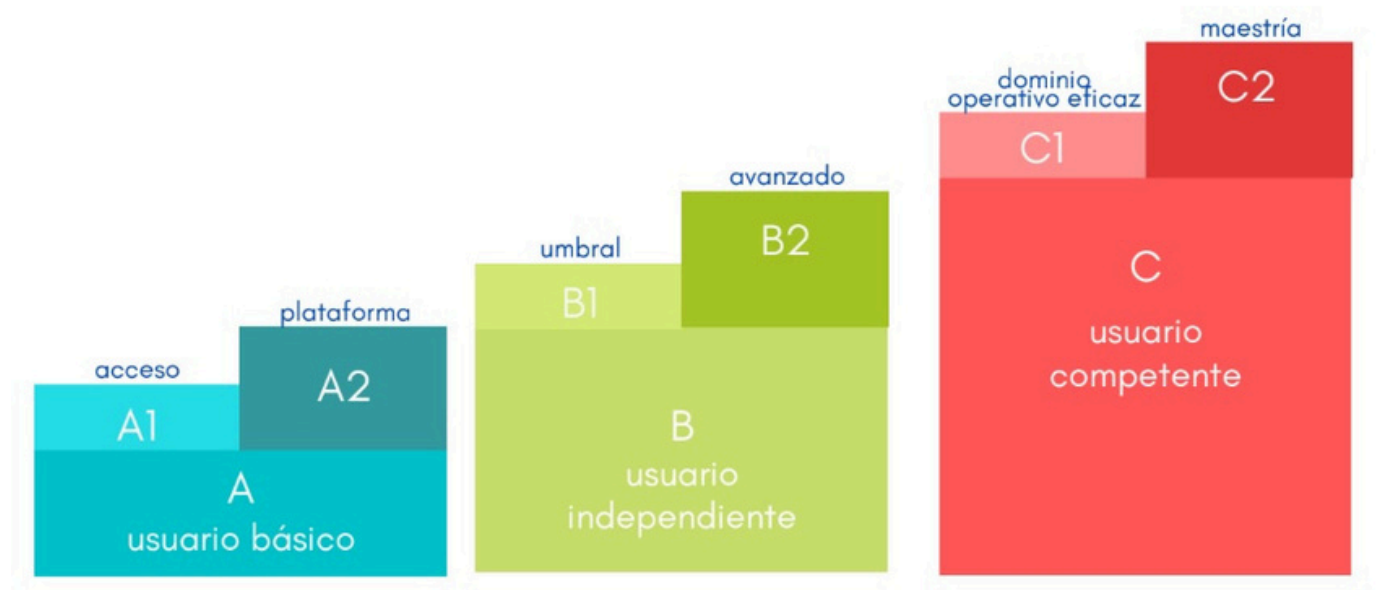

WHAT YOU GET

- You will be able to: understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to familiar topics, such as personal and family information, shopping, places of interest, work, and everyday life.
- Communicate with local people about simple, everyday matters, taking part in straightforward conversations about familiar or routine situations.
- Describe your past experiences and your surroundings in simple terms, as well as talk about your immediate needs and everyday situations.

A1 is the most exciting and challenging course. Everything is new and you will have to be patient to get used to the new language and learning procedures. Many games and participatory activities await you but you will need to be disciplined and complete all the tasks. **Don't worry. I will be supporting you every step of the way.**

ONLINE LESSONS

Classes are offered individually or in pairs if you choose to bring a friend or classmate. We recommend attending two classes per week to maintain a steady pace and make consistent progress.

HOMEWORK

Homework assignments will be provided after every class for you to complete before the next one. While completing the assignments is optional, we strongly recommend doing them, as regular practice will help you reinforce what you have learned and make faster progress.

MATERIALS

You don't have to bring anything to class or buy books. **We work with flashcards and online platforms.** The assignments and exercises are online word documents.

EXAMS

For students who wish to take an official Spanish language exam, optional exam preparation is also available to help you prepare for the requirements and format of the official examination.

MOVIES & SERIES



We will start by watching very popular movies and series. Movie classics that we have all seen at some time or another in the two types of dubbing supported: "European Spanish" and "Latin Spanish".

READINGS



We will read short and simple texts about everyday life. Texts specifically designed for A1 students.

LISTENINGS



We will work with simple songs and listening's comprehension activities in different types of accents.

WRITINGS



You will be able to correctly write a presentation of who you are, your interests and simple opinions.

CONVERSATION



You will learn to communicate in a simple way about yourself and the main things around you. Every class we will have a short conversation. If you choose the *Remote Learning Program* and do not attend the virtual classes you will have to attend a one-to-one conversation class once a month.
